REPORT OF THE INSPECTION COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED FOR INSPECTION
OF THAKUR DHARAM SINGH COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, KATHUA FOR
RENEWAL/ EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY AFFILIATION FOR THE SESSION
2024-25 AND 2025-26.

The inspection committee for inspection of Thakur Dharam Singh College of Education, Kathua to renew/extend its temporary affiliation for the session 2024-25 & 2025-26 visited the college on 28.01.2026 in pursuance to letter No. CDC/2026/4047-49 dated 16.01.2026. After the arrival at the scheduled time, the committee members were duly apprised about the vision, mission and objectives of the college through power point presentation. Committee members examined all the records submitted by the college and made following observations:

1. College has been approved by National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE) for running B. Ed course with an intake of 50. As per record, there are a total of 11 faculty members (including Principal) engaged by the college which is way short of the requirements as per NCTE. College was directed to appoint more teaching faculty and submit the joining reports of all the faculty members working in the college to the office of CDC.
2. For the session 2025-26, the college has admitted 50 students against total approved intake of 50. The Principal was directed to notify the schedule of the class-work so as to ensure the timely completion of the syllabus.
3. Further there are total of 05 technical/support/non-teaching staff engaged by the college including a Librarian. College was directed to hire more support staff at the earliest. College also needs to pay salaries of the staff strictly as per rules for the Teaching as well as non-teaching staff.
4. The College has conducted the meeting of management committee on 06/05/2025 and it was further impressed upon that the college must conduct the meeting of management committee as per statutes at the earliest for pursuance of the developmental efforts.
5. The library in particular housed about 3000 books, journals, magazines and other reference material for the students. College has appointed a Librarian on regular basis urgently. The college must continue to purchase more books annually as per statutes and as per requirements of the students.

6. The computer lab of the college has 20 computers in total with internet and printing facilities.
7. Further, the infrastructure of the college needs to be upgraded at the first instance by installation of fresh furniture, lightings, curtains, exhaust fans in the classrooms/library/laboratories/hallways and smart-boards should be installed in classrooms given the contemporary requirements of the curriculum.
8. The College must also install proper signages and boards inside and outside the premises for proper identification of the college.

Recommendations

In view the inspection conducted, the committee hereby recommends for extension of temporary affiliation in the favour of the college for session 2024-2025 and 2025-26 for imparting teaching instructions for B. Ed Course provided the shortfalls and deficiencies observed/noticed by the inspection committee are duly addressed within one month and a detailed action taken report for the purpose along with documentary evidence is submitted to the office of CDC.
